Day 1 Buenos Aires. Arrival and reception at the airport. Transfer to the hotel. In the afternoon, panoramic tour of the city starting at Plaza de Mayo, witness of some of the most important events of the country from 1810. Then continue to the neighbourhood of La Boca, and finish in Palermo and Recoleta. During the tour, we visit a city's icon: the Colón Theatre, considered one of the best opera houses in the world, recognized for its acoustic and artistic value of its construction. We have the opportunity to visit: The Foyer, the Golden Room, the Gallery of the

Busts and Main Room. At the end, return to the hotel.

Day 2 Buenos Aires. ☺ Morning at leisure. In the afternoon, departure from the hotel to visit two of the most representative museums dedicated to different aspects and periods of argentinian art and culture. According to the preferences of each passenger, it is possible to choose between the following museums: National Museum of Fine Arts, Museum of Decorative Art, Jose Hernández Museum and Buenos Aires' Museum of Latin American Art (MALBA). At the end of the tour, we enjoy a coffee in Errazuriz Palace that is home to the Museum of Decorative Art, which is a fitting example of the Belle Epoque in 'porteño' area. Finally, return to the hotel.

Day 3 Buenos Aires. ☺ Morning at leisure and in the afternoon encounter with Urban Art. Discover why Buenos Aires is one of the world capitals of Street Art. At this tour, you can contemplate the work of more than 50 urban

artists and the fascinating stories behind their murals. You may explore different areas of the city and photograph giant walls not listed in the tourist guides. We finish the tour with a stop at a bar where you can breathe urban art.

Day 4 Buenos Aires. ☺ ☹ We leave the city and drive to the neighbourhood of Mataderos (in Spanish, 'mataderos' means slaughterhouses), where the countryside and the city lived for a while since in 1889, a slaughter of cattle was founded. When the neighbourhood began to populate with workers attracted by the new activity, it received the nickname 'Nueva Chicago' (the New Chicago), in allusion to the city from the United States, centre of the meat industry. Nowadays, an outdoor fair is held in the neighbourhood, in which is possible to see a mix of horse dressage and runs, lasso throwing, guitar-playing, live music and typical dances. At lunch time, we can taste some of the typical foods of the country such as

empanadas and locro (meat and vegetable stew).

Day 5 Buenos Aires. ☺ In the morning we visit some bars of the city, that have special historical relevance and for that reason deserve to be called 'Remarkable'. During the tour, we stop at El Ateneo Splendid. It is an antique theatre that nowadays functions as a bookstore, which is known as one of the most beautiful libraries in the world, by the newspaper The Guardian.

At due time, transfer to the airport to board your flight.

Operational notes:

Day 2: The National Museum of Fine Arts, National Museum of Decorative Art, and Jose Hernández Museum close on Mondays. MALBA (Buenos Aires' Museum of Latin American Art) closes on Tuesdays.

Day 3: The Graffiti Tour operates on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturday in the afternoon, in a shared service.

Day 4: Mataderos' Fair only operates on Sundays except from January to March. During those months, it is replaced by San Telmo Fair.

Day 1 Buenos Aires. Arrival and reception at the airport. Transfer to the hotel. In the afternoon, we make a walking tour through the historic center of the city. Our walk takes us from the Plaza de Mayo, witness since 1810 of many popular expressions, to San Telmo Neighborhood, where we breathe a bohemian atmosphere. During the walk, we sit in a 'remarkable' bar to enjoy a tradition of people from Buenos Aires: coffee. In the meantime, we talk about some of the passions that we will

understand better in the following days.

Day 2 Buenos Aires.   We get to know some details of the life of a figure who aroused mixed feelings, throughout history: Evita, who was Argentina's First Lady and became a massively popular celebrity and icon to Argentinians, as well as a source of great controversy. The tour takes us to places that tell us about her life, since the moment she arrived at the city, passing by those places that had historic relevance in the development of her legacy, to her final resting in Recoleta's cemetery. After having a drink in a bar related to her history, we return to the hotel. In the evening, dinner at Santa Evita, a themed bar that pays tribute to Eva Perón.

Day 3 Buenos Aires.   If we talk about Tango, we'd better know about the history of Carlos Gardel, the greatest tango singer of all times. The tour covers important neighborhoods: San Nicolas, passing by some places where he was raised, Café

Tortoni and Café Los Angelitos, both remarkable bars that he frequented; El Ateneo Grand Espléndido, one of the most beautiful libraries according to foreign reviews, where used to function a theatre in which Gardel performed at some concerts; moreover, we visit Abasto, area that gave him the nickname of 'Morocho del Abasto' (Brunette from Abasto). Through a walking tour, we visit the house where he lived, today turned into a museum, Zelaya Passage with the singer's murals, Paseo Gardel with his monument and the corner 'Chanta Cuatro' where a 'tanguería' (where tango shows take place) called 'Esquina de Carlos Gardel' (Carlos Gardel's Corner) was located. On the way back, we have lunch at a traditional restaurant related to the history of Gardel. In the evening, we take a tango lesson and attend a dinner show, in order to continue discovering the magnetism of tango.

Day 4 Buenos Aires.   We say goodbye to the city, taking

part at one of the passions that divides 'porteños': Football. We drive to the neighborhood of La Boca, where Boca Juniors Club has its Stadium. While we walk its streets, we observe its colourful buildings and we discover that the neighborhood turns around yellow and blue, the colours of Boca Juniors. We visit the Museum of the stadium to tour its facilities and understand why it is called 'Bombonera'. We have lunch at El Cuartito, famous pizzeria for its fugazzetta (it is a pizza full of onions and mozzarella on a thick crust) and its walls decorated with photographs, flags and football team shirts. We taste pizza, part of the football ceremony. At due time, transfer to the airport.

Operational note:

Day 2: According to availability, passengers will visit one of the buildings where her foundation had offices: the CGT (General Confederation of Labor) or 'Legislatura Porteña'. Santa Evita Restaurant closes on Sundays.
Day 3: Carlos Gardel's Museum closes on Tuesdays.

Day 1 Buenos Aires. ①

Arrival and reception. At due time, walking tour through the historical center of the city. Our tour takes us from Plaza de Mayo, witness since 1810 of various popular expressions, to San Telmo neighbourhood, where we breathe a bohemian atmosphere. During the walk, we enter the San Telmo Market and we sit in a typical bar to enjoy a porteño custom (porteño is the nickname that the inhabitants of Buenos Aires' city receive): coffee. At the end, we visit the Zanjón de

Granados, where it is possible to visit a tunnel with more than four centuries of Buenos Aires' history. In the evening, we go on a Tour of Bodegones (taverns), former stores where the gauchos and criollos used to meet, that evolved into restaurants where Argentinians eat like at home. We start with a stop to take a vermouth or appetizer. This drink was originally made from medicinal or digestive herbs, but then evolved into spicy wines or signature cocktails. We try an aperitif, while the guide tells us a little more about this ritual and the Spanish and Italian influences in Argentinian cuisine. We end at a bodegón, where we have dinner, that lacks of gourmet touches, but we guarantee that your palate will be grateful.

Day 2 Buenos Aires. ② ③ Day at leisure in order to enjoy an optional tour. We suggest that you should get to know the city's north area by making a

walking tour, in which you will admire the architecture of one neighbourhood of the city. At night, we enjoy a closed-door gastronomic experience, which explores new ways of Argentinian Barbecue 'Fogón Experience'. The five-step tasting menu was designed to combine new grill techniques with truly and tasted Argentinian recipes, that raise the Asado to a new level, combining some of the best boutique wines of Argentina.

Day 3 Buenos Aires. ③ ④ A little before noon, we start with this tour that leads us to taste one of the typical meals of Buenos Aires: pizza.

While we move around pizzerías, we approach to its history, we understand the Genoese, Sicilian and Neapolitan influences and the main differences that set us apart with Italian pizza. In order to know the Argentinian pizza you can choose one of these circuits that we have prepared. In these routes,

we visit three historical pizzerías where we will understand their importance in Buenos Aires' gastronomy once we taste their speciality.

We recommend combining this experience with a tour around La Boca, where you can breathe pizza's culture.

Day 4 Buenos Aires. ④ Time at leisure to continue discovering the different gastronomic corners of the city and make a short stop at a historical café (remarkable bars) to enjoy a "cortado" (coffee prepared with a few drops of milk) to say goodbye to Buenos Aires. At due time, transfer to the airport.

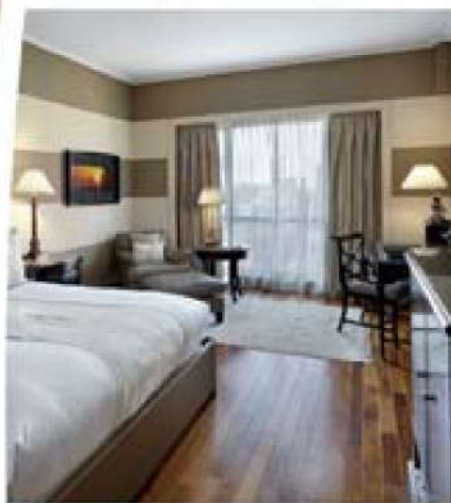

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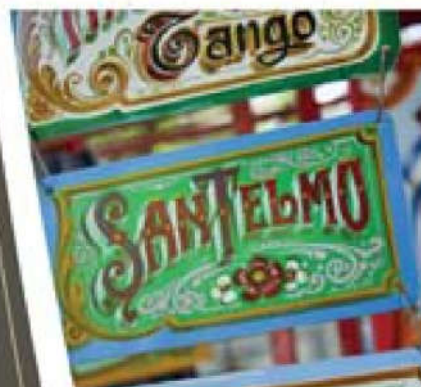
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Tango Experience

Day 1 Buenos Aires. (L) (D)

Arrival, reception and transfer to the hotel. We begin to introduce ourselves into the world of tango and have dinner at The Querandí where we enjoy the meal and a show that tells the history of the tango.

Day 2 Buenos Aires. (B) (L)

Today we walk along the neighbourhoods that gave rise to the tango, and we go into details that help us to understand why UNESCO declared it an Intangible Cultural Heritage.

Our tour takes us around four neighbourhoods where the Tango was developed: La Boca,

mentioned as the birthplace of the tango by the influence of immigrant people: San Telmo, where it expanded in bars such as Bar Sur, the first Tango show and the corner of El Viejo Almacén, considered the temple of the tango that was declared as City Heritage; Boedo and Almagro, birthplace of many characters and bars of tango.

At the end of the tour, we stop at Las Violetas, chosen as the best remarkable bar of the city, where we will enjoy a different lunch.

Day 3 Buenos Aires. (B) Today we explore one of the most aristocratic neighbourhoods of the city, La Recoleta, which at that time when tango was not accepted by the high society, kept the secret in bars where the malevos and compadritos gathered around to enjoy the tango. We tour the sites where used to be located the Hansem's Café, El Pabellón de las Rosas, Armenonville and the Palais de Glace. In the latter it is where the tango released for the

high society and the only that is still open. The tour includes some curiosities as the tango's sidewalk where the basics steps of tango are drawn and a stop at the Esquina de Aníbal Troilo, a remarkable bar in honour of an exponent of the tango's golden age, to take a break.

In the evening, we attend at a tour of milongas where besides learning some traditions about this rhythm, we are going to take a tango lesson by professors.

Day 4 Buenos Aires. (B) (L) (D) If we talk about Tango, what is best way of knowing the history about Carlos Gardel, the greatest tango singer of all time?

The tour covers San Nicolas neighborhood, walking by some places where he raised, Café Tortoni and Café los Angelitos, both remarkable bars that he frequented. Moreover, we visit El Abasto, the area that gave him the nickname of 'Morochito del Abasto' (Brunette from Abasto). Through a walking tour, we visit the house where he lived, today turned into

a museum, Zelaya Passage with murals dedicated to him, Paseo Gardel with his monument and the corner "Chanta Cuatro" where a 'tanguería' (where tango shows take place) called 'Esquina de Carlos Gardel' (Carlos Gardel's Corner) was located. On the way back, we have lunch at a traditional restaurant related to the history of Gardel.

We say goodbye to the city attending a dinner show at Rojo Tango in El Cabaret, an intimate place inspired in the tango's clubs of the city in 1920.

Day 5 Buenos Aires. (B) At due time, transfer to the airport to board on the scheduled flight.

Operational notes:

Day 3: The choice of the milonga is subjected to availability. In regular, operates on Mondays, Wednesdays and Sundays. In private, it is daily.

Day 4: The Carlos Gardel Museum closes on Tuesdays.

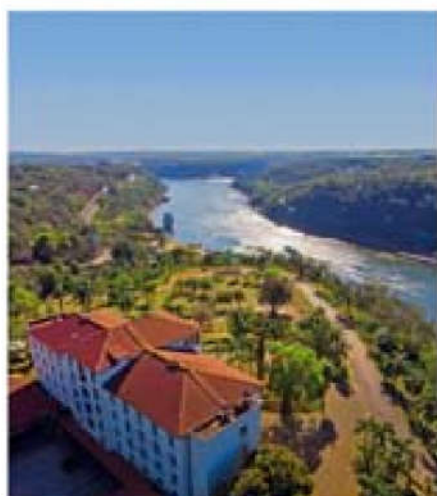

Day 1 Buenos Aires. Reception at the Buenos Aires' International Airport and transfer to the hotel. In the afternoon, city tour passing by some of the most interesting spots Plaza de Mayo, Government's House, Cabildo (City Hall), the Metropolitan Cathedral, Avenida de Mayo, Congress, Colón's Theatre, La Boca neighbourhood, Palermo, the Planetarium and La Recoleta. Then, we make a short visit at the Popular Art's Museum of Jose Hernández that has been dedicated to collect, document, investigate, exhibit and promote the popular art. It has collections of many specialities and

handcrafts (silverware, textiles, leather, glasses, basketry, poles and bones).

Day 2 Buenos Aires / San Antonio de Areco.



Early in the morning, transfer to San Antonio de Areco, a village located at 110 km (69 miles) from Buenos Aires and it is famous due to the conservation of the creole customs. In our way, we learn about one of the most popular traditions of the Argentinian people: the 'mate'. This drink represents a language and code that are worth to share. As soon as we arrive at the historic quarter and before our first visit, we stop at some historic bars at the city where rural people used to socialize with city people. Many of these bars were stores and there is a lot of history over 200 years in their walls. After an aperitif, we visit the Gauchesco Ricardo Güiraldes Museum where we can appreciate the creole cultural heritage.

It has seven exhibition halls, a recreation of the century pulpería 'La Blanqueada' and objects that belonged to important characters of the Argentinian history. These buildings as well as the San Antonio de Padua Parochial Church, the Municipal Intendence's house and the old quarter of Estancia La Porteña were declared National Historic Monument.

Return to the historic quarter for lunch and then we have time for a walk along the centric roads that are perfect for the Antique and silverware lovers.

In the afternoon, we accommodate at a traditional Estancia of San Antonio de Areco called 'La Porteña', built over 2 centuries ago and one of the oldest of the region.

Day 3 San Antonio de Areco.

  Day at leisure to enjoy the activities the Estancia offers. -Tour around the historic quarter, Ricardo Güiraldes' room and his

desk, named 'El Rincón del Poeta' (The Poet's Corner).

-Guided walks and horse rides through the Estancia as well as the forest, to the Areco River, passing through different pastures with views to the agriculture.

-Carriage rides.

-Show of creole skills.

Day 4 San Antonio de Areco / Buenos Aires.

Time at leisure to enjoy the Estancia's activities. After lunch, transfer to the airport to board on the scheduled flight.

Operational notes:

Day 1: Popular Art's Museum of Jose Hernández closes on Tuesdays.

Day 3: If Ricardo Güiraldes' room is booked, it will not be possible to visit his desk.

The show of creole skills is during weekends and it is subject to weather conditions.

To keep in mind:

The activities of the Estancia are subject to their own schedule.

Day 1 Córdoba. ☺ Arrival at Córdoba Airport. Reception and transfer. In the afternoon, we make a walking tour by the Foundational Area of Córdoba, visiting the Jesuit Block, located in the centre of the city. Its great historical, architectural, testimonial and cultural value made UNESCO declare it as a Humanity's Heritage in 2000, along with the Road of Jesuit Estancias. This includes: the

Domestic Chapel, the National College of Monserrat, La Compañía de Jesús Church, the former headquarters of the National University of Cordoba and the Residence.

Day 2 Córdoba. ☺ ☹ ☺ We continue exploring the city, while we experience the fervent activity of the commercial, popular and market area. After lunch, we discover another side of the city through cultural walks, museums and emblematic buildings to finish the afternoon enjoying the little streets and bohemian passages of Güemes.

Day 3 Córdoba. ☺ ☹ ☺ After breakfast we begin a special tour, visiting Alta Gracia, which contains a Jesuitical Estancia, declared a Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO. This important productive establishment consisted of the Residence, the Obraje ('the Manufacturing' that nowadays is a school), the productive land (where houses were built), the

Tajamar (nowadays, a recreation center and promenade), the church and the sanctuary. After lunch, we continue our tour, touching historical aspects of Argentina. We approach Che Guevara's life, spending some time at Guevara's family house, La Perla and Museum of Memory, that involves recent aspects of the Argentinian history.

Day 4 Córdoba / Estancia La Paz Town. ☺ ☹ ☺ In the morning we head north to the province to discover a journey full of history, culture and traditions through Jesuit Estancias, former agricultural establishments administered by the Jesuit order, declared a Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO. We visit Estancia Jesus Maria, Bodega and Chacra in Colonia Caroya, with lunch included. In the evening, we arrive at Estancia La Paz Town. This is a place rich in native and Jesuit history, furthermore its importance consists in that it

has been Julio Argentino Roca's summer house (ex-president) and, in fact, during that period it reached its greatest splendor.

Day 5 Estancia La Paz Town.

☺ ☹ ☺ Day at leisure to enjoy the place and live a true rural experience, take advantage of the facilities and the environment. In the afternoon, we enjoy a fun horseback ride to the river. Besides the Estancia's activities, there are golf, polo and relax experiences.

Day 6 Estancia La Paz Town / Córdoba. ☺ ☹ Morning at leisure and after lunch we return to Córdoba, through Sierras Chicas circuit, visiting Ascochinga, La Granja and Candonga Chapel. Transfer to the airport.

Operational notes:

Day 1: The Jesuit Block remains closed on Mondays.

Days 3, 4 & 5: The Estancias remain closed on Mondays.

Day 6: It is required a flight after 7 PM.

Day 1 Córdoba. Arrival at Córdoba's Airport and transfer to the selected hotel. In the afternoon, we make a walking tour where we visit the Jesuit Block which the main buildings of the former Jesuit Province of Paraguay: the church, the Jesuit priests' residence, the university and Colegio Convictorio de Monserrat. Then time at leisure to relax.

Day 2 Córdoba. **B L** We leave the city towards a region full of history, culture and local traditions. The first visit is Jesuit Estancia of Jesús María. In 1618, the Jesuits acquired twenty thousand grape varieties, the mill and animals. After years of work, the Jesuits could make the first American wine served in Europe and they named it 'Lagrimilla de Oro'. After such interesting history dose, it is time to explore other side of the region: The viniculture. We will visit three wineries: a small winery, another one with a traditional vineyard and long tradition in the industry; and Terra Camiare: a gourmet vineyard where we discover its wine and local products such as cheese and salami, which is a famous sausage in the area. Return to Córdoba.

Day 3 Córdoba / San Javier. **B L D** In the morning, we go to a mountain area with excellent

views and stunning landscapes: San Javier, a quiet town located at the foot of Champaqui Hill in Traslasierra Valley. There, we will visit a winery where red, white and rosé wines are elaborated by locals. During the guided visit, we will be able to appreciate its facilities, which are famous because they have two fermentation tanks and a wine cellar where 28 oak barrels store more than 6000 liters. After that, we continue towards Posada Rural La Matilde which is a benchmark of the region due to its philosophy based on biodynamic, sustainability and ecological practices. Accommodation and dinner.

Day 4 San Javier. **B L D** Day to enjoy your stay in La Matilde, walking across the vineyards, farm, garden and corrals. Its location, temperature conditions, annual precipitation and

sunlight add to its terroir unique characteristics which allow La Matilde to develop organic and biodynamic varieties of Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon and Tannat.

Day 5 San Javier / Córdoba.

B L After breakfast, we start our trip back to Córdoba's airport. On the way, we discover Altas Cumbres by visiting small towns or a vineyard with its locals artisans and turns this trip into a unique experience. At some point of the trip, we enjoy a gourmet picnic in middle of the mountain landscape. After this we continue towards Córdoba's airport.

Operational notes:

Day 1: The Jesuit Block remains closed on Mondays.

Day 2: Wineries' order may be modified due to operational reasons.

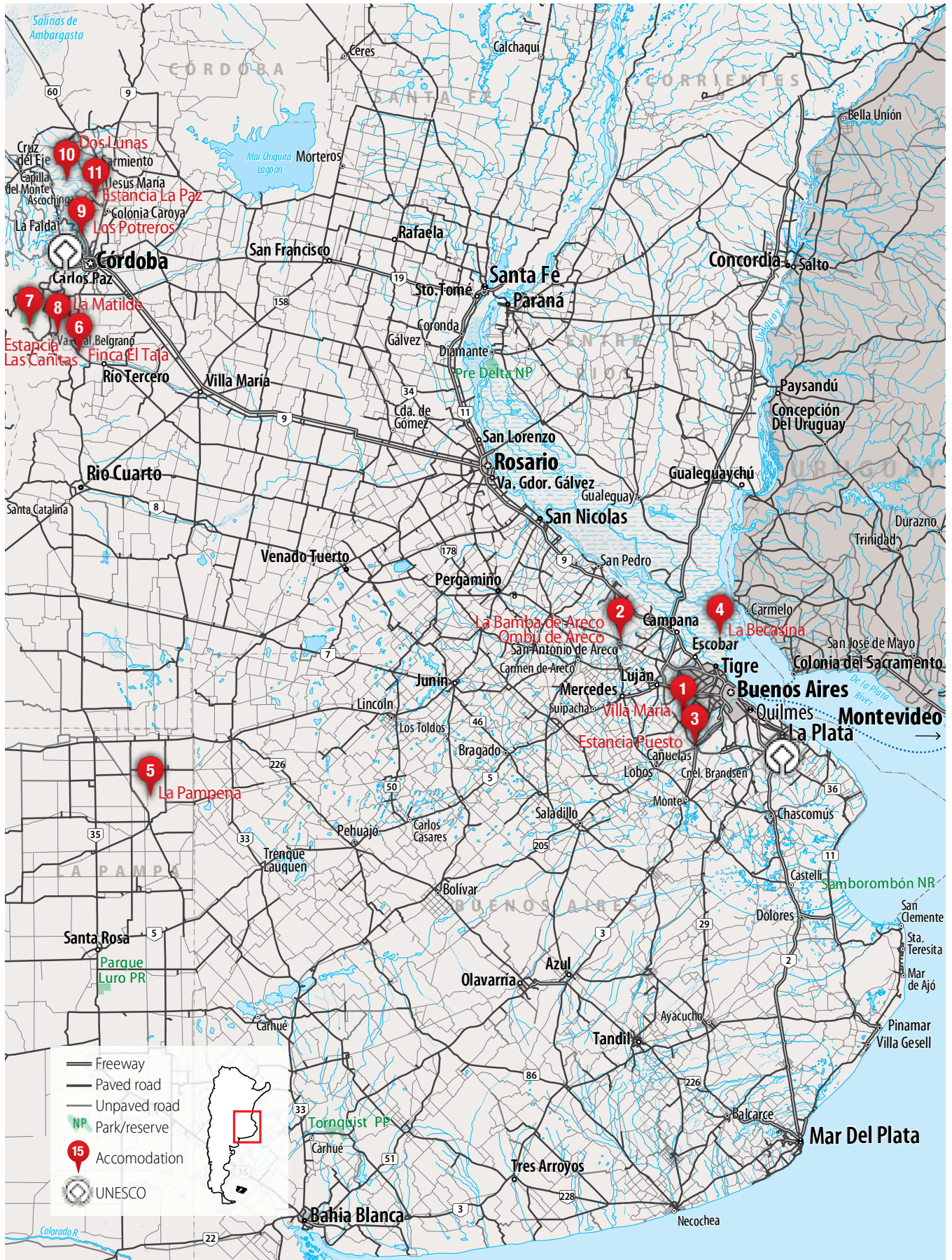

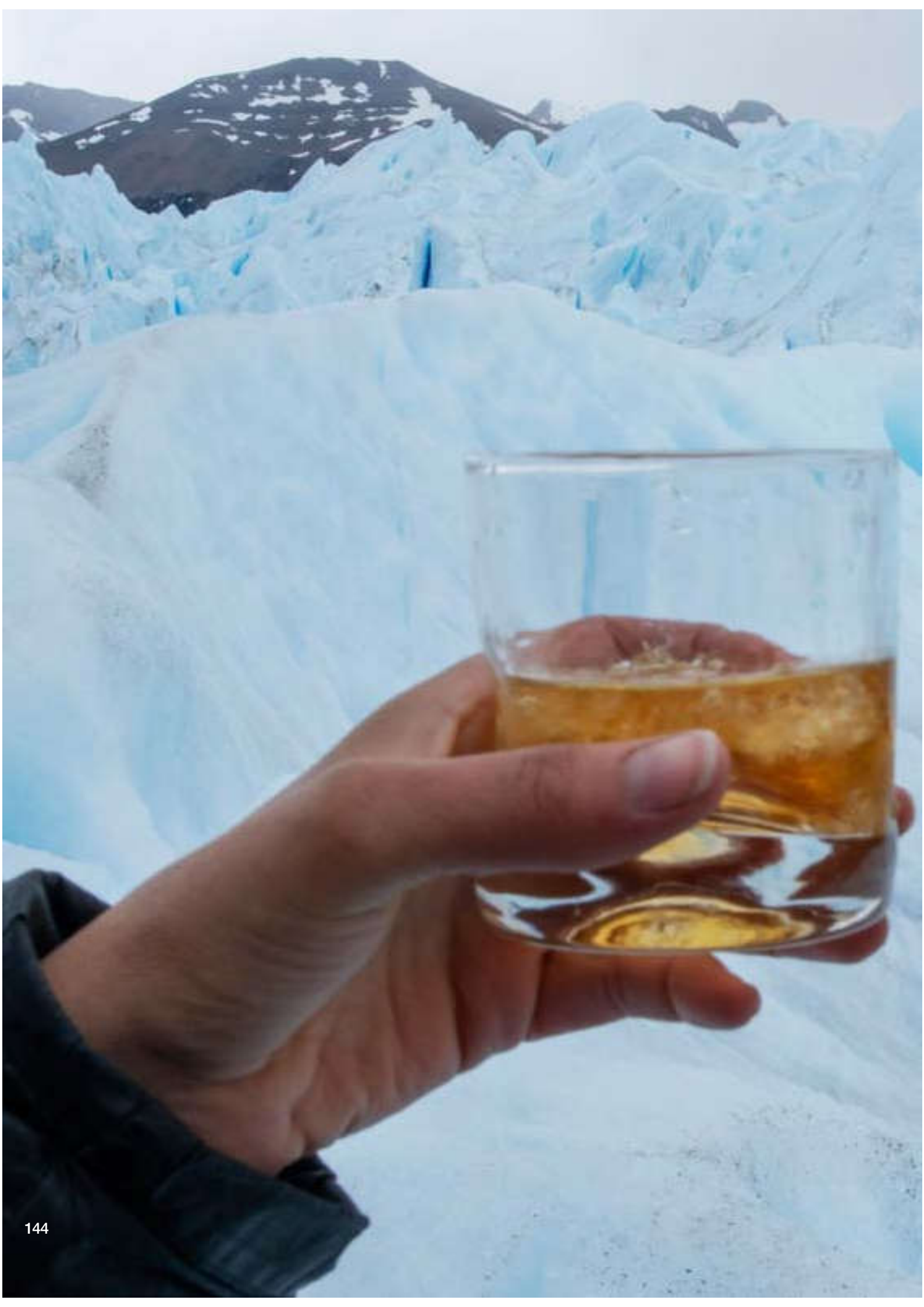

The island is 11 km long and covers a total of 3700 hectares,

Day 1 Bariloche. Arrival and reception at the airport. After we check in, we explore Bariloche through the small circuit. Our tour borders Nahuel Huapi Lake to Campanario Hill, to which we ascend to obtain excellent views of the surrounding lakes. We continue to Llao Llao Peninsula, San Eduardo Chapel and Pañuelo Port, near there we make a short hike to a forest of Arrayanes. Further on, we arrive at a natural balcony from where we can admire Moreno Lake and Llao Llao Peninsula, from there we start our

way back to stop at a brewery to taste some handmade beer. Beer, a tradition brought by immigrants, is one of the main gastronomic and tourist products of the city. An excellent way to end the day.

Day 2 Bariloche. ⓑ Among the infinite options that Bariloche offers, those trekking lovers can choose to reach the Castaño Overa Glacier. During the walk, they will be able to see through the forest a waterfall that emerges from the hanging glacier and further, the Tronador Hill, which is another alternative for trekking. It owes its name to the roars that the ice blocks detachments produce.

Day 3 Bariloche / Lakes Crossing / Puerto Varas. ⓑ Early in the morning, we depart to Pañuelo Port and start the Lake Crossing or Andean Crossing. First, we sail towards Puerto Blest, from there we take a bus to Puerto Frias. At this point, we embark to sail the Frias Lake until we reach Frias Port where

we must complete the border procedures. We continue by bus to Peulla and after lunch (not included), we set sail for Petrohue sailing the De Todos Los Santos Lake. If weather allows, we can enjoy views of Osorno Volcano, Puntagudo Volcano and Cerro Tronador. We continue to Puerto Varas bordering Llanquihue Lake. Arrival at Puerto Varas and transfer to the hotel.

Day 4 Puerto Varas. ⓑ Day at leisure to enjoy this maritime city making an optional excursion to the Chiloé's Archipelago, an island with cultural and natural riches that deserves a visit.

Explore this mythical island with its colorful wooden churches, 16 of which have been declared World Heritage Sites by UNESCO.

Day 5 Puerto Varas / Bariloche. ⓑ Today we return to Argentina by land, enjoying the magnificent view of the Osorno Volcano. We reach Frutillar, Puerto Octay and Puyehue, finally arriving at

the border Crossing Paso Cardinal Samore, where we carry out the migratory procedures. Once in Argentina, our next stop is Villa La Angostura from where we take a boat trip to Arrayanes' Forest, packed of 300-year old tree specimens, declared an Intangible Area and Natural Monument. From there we begin the return sailing to Pañuelo Port. Transfer to the hotel.

Day 6 Bariloche. ⓑ Morning at leisure to take an optional kayaking tour in Moreno Lake. At due time, transfer to the local airport to board the scheduled flight.

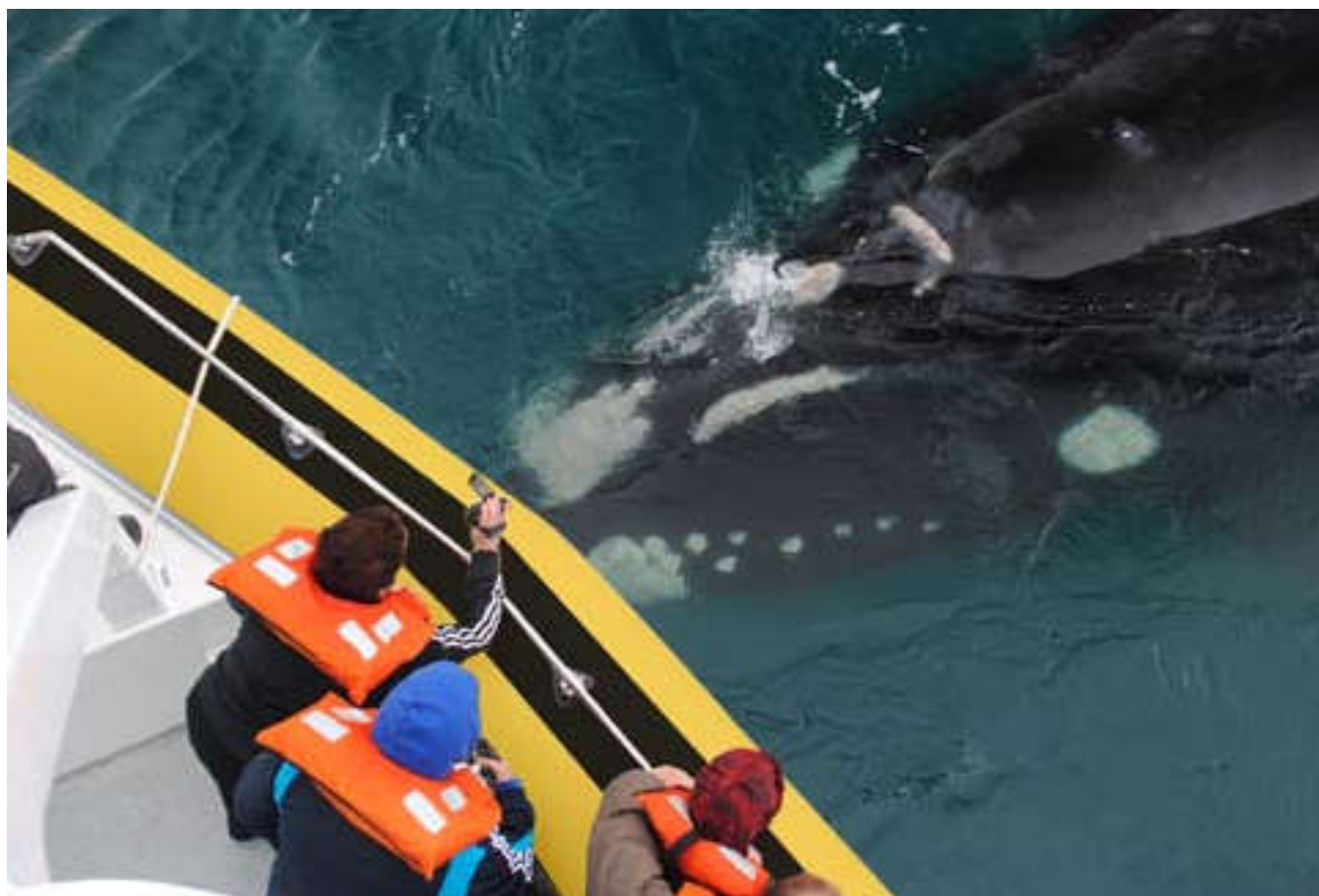

Arrival and reception at the airport of Trelew and transfer to El Pedral, a countryside hotel, located in Punta Ninfas, part of Peninsula Valdes Biosphere Reserve. As soon as we check in, the guide explains us about the activities offered during the stay.

Day 2 El Pedral. (B) (L) (D) We keep on enjoying the activities offered by the lodge among which you can select:

- Visit to Punta Ninfas Lighthouse
- Walk with Penguins Visit to the penguin rookery
- Walk with Elephant Seals
- Self-guided trails.

If you visit the lodge in October or November, we suggest optionally a whale watching to observe them approaching to the coasts of the Golfo Nuevo. This watching requires leaving the lodge in order to go to Puerto Pirámides, from where the activity takes place.

Day 3 El Pedral / Bahía Bustamante. (B) (L) (D) Departure to Bahía Bustamante, a Patagonian estancia surrounded by 360° of pure nature. Close to the sea, within Patagonia Austral National Park, declared an Area of Importance for Bird Conservation, being one of the few places in the world which concentrates such abundance and diversity of birds and marine mammals.

Day 4 & 5 Bahía Bustamante. (B) (L) (D) Days to enjoy the activities offered by Bahía Bustamante, which are planned

the previous night, according to the weather forecast and the tide.

- **Boat ride:** (3 / 4 hours approx.) We cruise along seaweed meadows of Malaspina Cove, to watch penguins and birds such as petrels, terns, olrog's seagull and oyster catchers.
- **The Peninsula:** (4 hours approx.) Ideal to visit by walking, biking, 4x4 or horseback riding.
- **Petrified Forest:** (4/5 hours approx.) A trekking in this place is a living proof of how the landscape looked 60 million years ago.
- **Penguin Island:** (3 hours approx.) During times of low tide, this island is connected to the mainland allowing us to visit and watch the penguins and their nests from nearby. On the way, it is also usual to see maras, choiques and armadillos.
- **Cape Aristizabal:** (4 a 5 horas approx.) A 4x4 drive to reach Cape Aristizabal, an important rockery cape, characterized by its imposing landscape,

dominated by the sea, the stone beaches and fauna.

- **De Piedra Canyon:** (4-5 hours approx.) Trekking through a canyon where a river used to be, until reaching the sea shore. Its 15-metres-high walls (50 ft.), are composed of rocks originated from the Jurassic period of the Mesozoic era.
- **Historical and Seaweeds Tour:** (1-2 hours approx.) Walk through the village to learn about the history, its founder and its inhabitants.
- **Rural activities:** (4 hours approx.)

Day 3 Puerto Pirámides / Puerto Madryn. ③ ① We head for Punta Norte and reach Estancia San Lorenzo, arriving at the only penguin colony in the Peninsula. Due to the controlled number of visitors, it keeps its environment intact. At the end, we visit Punta Norte and return to Puerto Madryn.

Travelled distance: 232 km (144 miles)

Day 4 Puerto Madryn / Comodoro Rivadavia. ③ ① ②

Morning departure to National Route 3 towards Camarones Bay. On the way, we visit Cape Dos Bahías penguin colony, and very close, an amphitheatre where an enormous colony of South American sea lions and South American Fur seals shelter is located. After lunch (box lunch), we take again the Route 3 to arrive at Comodoro Rivadavia. Travelled distance: 440 km (273 miles)

Day 5 Comodoro Rivadavia / Puerto Deseado. ③ ① ②

Departure by National Route 3 to Fitz Roy/ Olivia Cove and continue to the Petrified Forest of Jaramillo (National Monument of Petrified Forest). This is the oldest forest and the largest fossil trees in the world. After lunch (box lunch), we continue towards Estancia La Madrugada where we appreciate the breeding of sheep. Visit to Duraznillo Canyon, where one of the world's most important reserves of sea lions and sea elephants is located. Arrival at Puerto Deseado.

Travelled distance: 544 km - 170 gravel road (338 miles-105 gravel road)

Day 6 Puerto Deseado. ③ ②

Today we enjoy a boat trip to meet the Rockhopper Penguin (*Eudyptes chrysocome*), which is 60 cm (23") high and has a weight between 3 and 3,5 kg (6 or 7 lb). It is also known as Silly Jumper Bird because of its special manner of moving: jumping. In order to meet them we sail to the Penguin Island, declared

Marine Park since it is one of the Patagonian sites with more marine biodiversity. This location is the only Penguin Colony where the Rockhopper and the Magellanic Penguins live together.

Day 7 Puerto Deseado / Comodoro Rivadavia. ③

Morning at leisure to enjoy the city and visit the museum of Swift Corvett, important English warship sunk in 1770. In the afternoon, return to Comodoro Rivadavia.

Total distance travelled: 293 km (187 miles)

Day 8 Comodoro Rivadavia. ③

Morning at leisure. At due time, transfer to the airport.

Operational note:

Day 5: Visit to Duraznillo Canyon is subject to authorization.

Day 6: The boat trip is subject to climatic conditions.

To keep in mind:

We suggest adding an extra night in Puerto Deseado and take the sailing to Del Deseado Estuary or visit the Darwin Camp.

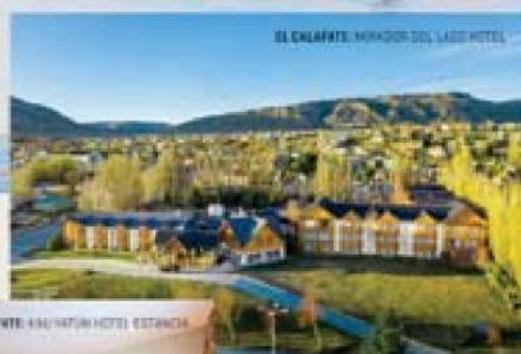

Day 1 El Calafate. Arrival and reception at the airport. If you have time, do not miss the opportunity to visit the Glaciarium, a museum dedicated to glaciology, or to do some activity that allows you to get to know the steppe by enjoying lunch or dinner.

Day 2 El Calafate. **B L** Today we explore part of Los Glaciares National Park, declared a Natural

Heritage Site by UNESCO. We leave from the hotel by the Route of the Patagonian Estancias, until we reach Nibepo Aike, where we enjoy lunch. In the afternoon, we sail Lake Argentino and we disembark in Playa de las Monedas to make a walk until the viewpoint of the glacier. We continue to Bajo Las Sombras Bay from where we transfer to the footbridges and we have the chance to admire the glacier from a different point of view, at a moment of the day when the silence and the detachments make this spectacle even better.

Day 3 El Calafate / Estancia Cristina. **B L D** Departure to Puerto Banderas where we embark to sail Lake Argentino and to arrive at a unique corner, Estancia Cristina. First, we sail through the Northern Arm in order to admire the Upsala Glacier and then we take Cristina Branch to finally arrive to Estancia Cristina. Founded in 1914, the Estancia still retains its essence, keeping alive

the history of this pioneer family that made this place their home. After checking in, a host will explain to us about the activities we can do during our stay.

Day 4 Estancia Cristina. **B L**

D We are able to choose between the following activities offered by the lodge:

Hiking/ Trekking:

- De Los Perros Cascade: 2,5 hours roundtrip. Low difficulty.
- Pesca Lagoon: 3 hours roundtrip. Low difficulty

On the way back, we continue sailing through Seno Cuevas until we reach the glacier of the same name and then continue the sea crossing until the very centre of Darwin's Mountain Range.

Day 4 Alakush / Ushuaia. ③

① In the morning we appreciate the impressive view of the Pared Glacier and then continue sailing

and disembark again in Caleta Maria. From there we head to Lakes Deseado and Despreciado. Lago Deseado, shared between Argentina and Chile and a fishing paradise, is one of the last ecosystems in Chile that remains pristine and wild. We continue the trip to the city of Ushuaia.

Day 2 Ushuaia. ③ ① Today we invite you to a day of trekking and for that we have prepared two proposals so you can select according to your preferences: To know one of the emblematic landscapes of Ushuaia like the

National Park Tierra del Fuego or to visit a lagoon, far from the most crowded paths of the island, the Laguna Turquesa. The National Park activity consists of an 8 km trekking combined with a boat trip in inflatable canoes through the waters of Lapataia River.

The walk to the Laguna Turquesa is one of the most beautiful places in Ushuaia, far from the beaten paths and with beautiful panoramic views.

Day 3 Ushuaia. ③ ① We leave by National Route N°3 and then we take Route J, which takes us towards the east of the island. At midday we arrive at Larsiphashaj River, where we begin preparations to row in inflatable canoes along the river and then through the Beagle Channel to Harberton Estancia. Once the activity finishes and we reach the hull of the estancia, we take a boat in the direction of Martillo Island, where we have the chance to see penguins in their breeding place from the boat. The boat trip

continues to Gable Island, where we have lunch and enjoy a walk.

Day 4 Ushuaia / El Calafate. ③ Day at leisure until the scheduled time of the transfer. Arrival at El Calafate.

Day 5 El Calafate. ③ ① We leave to Los Glaciares National Park, declared a Natural Heritage Site by UNESCO. From Bahia Bajo las Sombras, we cruise Rico Branch until we reach the shelter, starting point of a short walk in which we use crampons to climb to the ice and stay for almost two hours. On our way back to the shelter, we have lunch (box lunch) and then head for the walkways where we spend an hour to admire it from another perspective.

The glacier is an impressive river of ice with an area of 257 square kilometers, and with front walls up to 50 to 60 meters above the level of the lake.

Day 6 El Calafate. ③ ① Today we explore an area where few people have access. The road leads us to Roca Lake, where we embark

to sail Sur Branch, until we reach the starting point of our one-hour walk to Frias Lake. After crossing the lake in zodiac, we begin the last part of the trekking by a riverbed, until we get Anfiteatro de los Glaciares. Here, we have lunch (box lunch) while we admire Grande, Cubo and Dickson Glaciers. We return for the same path.

Day 7 El Calafate. ③ ① In the morning we prepare to do a kayaking activity in the Santa Cruz River or if you prefer a biking or hiking. Lunch is included in the three options, prior to departure to the airport.

Operational notes:

Day 2: National Park with trekking and canoes does not operate on Saturdays.

Day 3: Gable Island with canoes operates on MON/WED/FRI/SAT.

① Transfer by FIGAS (Falkland Islands Government Air Service) to Pebble Island. This island is the perfect combination between history and nature. Colonies of penguins, black-necked swans, raptors and some sea lions, is only a part of the fauna that can be found on this island where it also has several sites related to the 1982 war between Argentina and United Kingdom. To the west, we find the memorial to HMS Coventry, sunk on May 25, 1982, and a little further away, the memorial in commemoration of five Argentine soldiers who died when their recognition flight was shot down.

Day 5 & 6 Saunders Island. ③

① ① Transfer by FIGAS (Falkland Islands Government Air Service) to this island of volcanic origin. On the island, we have the chance to visit The Neck, an isthmus where you can observe diverse fauna such as: sea elephants, black-browed albatross and four species of penguins, King Penguin, Magellanic, Papua and Yellow Turtle. For those who like history, very close to the town are the ruins of Port Egmont (Port of the Crusade), the first British settlement, built on January 25, 1765. In 1770, a Spanish expedition expelled the British, but after this conflict, it was restored to the English again in 1771. Three years later, in 1774 the British left the island leaving a plaque in which they proclaimed their sovereignty over the territory. In the year 1776, the Spanish sent the plaque to Buenos Aires.

Day 7 Stanley Island. ③

Transfer by FIGAS to Stanley

where we enjoyed a tour of the city, which includes the old and historic part of the city and the modern area visiting the museum and the picturesque Gipsy Cove, a small beach area, where you can see penguins and a canyon from the Second World War which was left behind. In this area, there were battles between British and Germans during the war.

Day 8 Port Stanley / Mount Pleasant. ③ Transfer to Mount Pleasant to catch your flight.

Operational note:

Days 5 & 6: Accommodation on Saunders Island is in cabins, where the priority is the contact with nature. For that reason, during these days the gastronomy is available in food boxes.

To keep in mind:

Please, check the flight frequency from Córdoba, Río Gallegos or Punta Arenas.

to observe a full sequence of continental sediments, dating back to the Triassic Period. During the tour, we will be able to visit the most famous landforms of this Park: The Mushroom, the Submarine, the "Bochas" Court and Painted Valley. In addition, we visit the William Museum, where we can see real fossils and observe how archaeologists work with them. The traditional circuit finish when we visit the Interpretative Center, where we appreciate Ischigualasto's scientific value and observe the timeline from the Triassic period up to present. Continue to Villa Unión.

Travelled distance: 400 km (249 miles)
Travel time: 9 hours

Day 3 Villa Unión. ③ ① Early in the morning, we leave Villa Unión towards De La Troya Gorge, passing by formations like the Pyramid, which are the result of wind and water erosion. Little by

little, we begin the ascent to the Andes Mountain Range by the multi-coloured Del Peñón Gorge, to finally arrive to Portezuelo's Lagoon (4.350 MASL-14.271 ft.), access to Brava Lagoon. From October to March we are able to contemplate the magnificent pink flamingos that feed on plankton of icy salt water. If weather allows, we reach the lagoon's refuge, where we observe striking formations which are the geysers of Brava Lagoon. Return to Villa Unión.

Travelled distance: 376 km (233 miles)
Travel time: 9 hours

Day 4 Villa Unión / La Rioja or San Juan.

③ Today we visit the Talampaya National Park, declared Natural Heritage Site by UNESCO. In this park, we observe geological formations of the Triassic period, different from those seen in Ischigualasto. To visit its attractions, we take

an internal tour making stops at different stations, where we appreciate how wind and water erosion shaped formations such as The Gothic Cathedral, The Monk, The Tower, among others. Finally, return to La Rioja or San Juan's airport.

Travelled distance: 210 km (130 miles)
Travel time: 7/8 hours

Operational notes:

Day 1: Early arrival in the morning is required.

Day 3: between June and October, the access to Brava Lagoon is subject to weather and roads conditions. In some cases, it turns impossible to reach Brava Lagoon so it is necessary to return 10 km (6,2 miles) before reaching it.

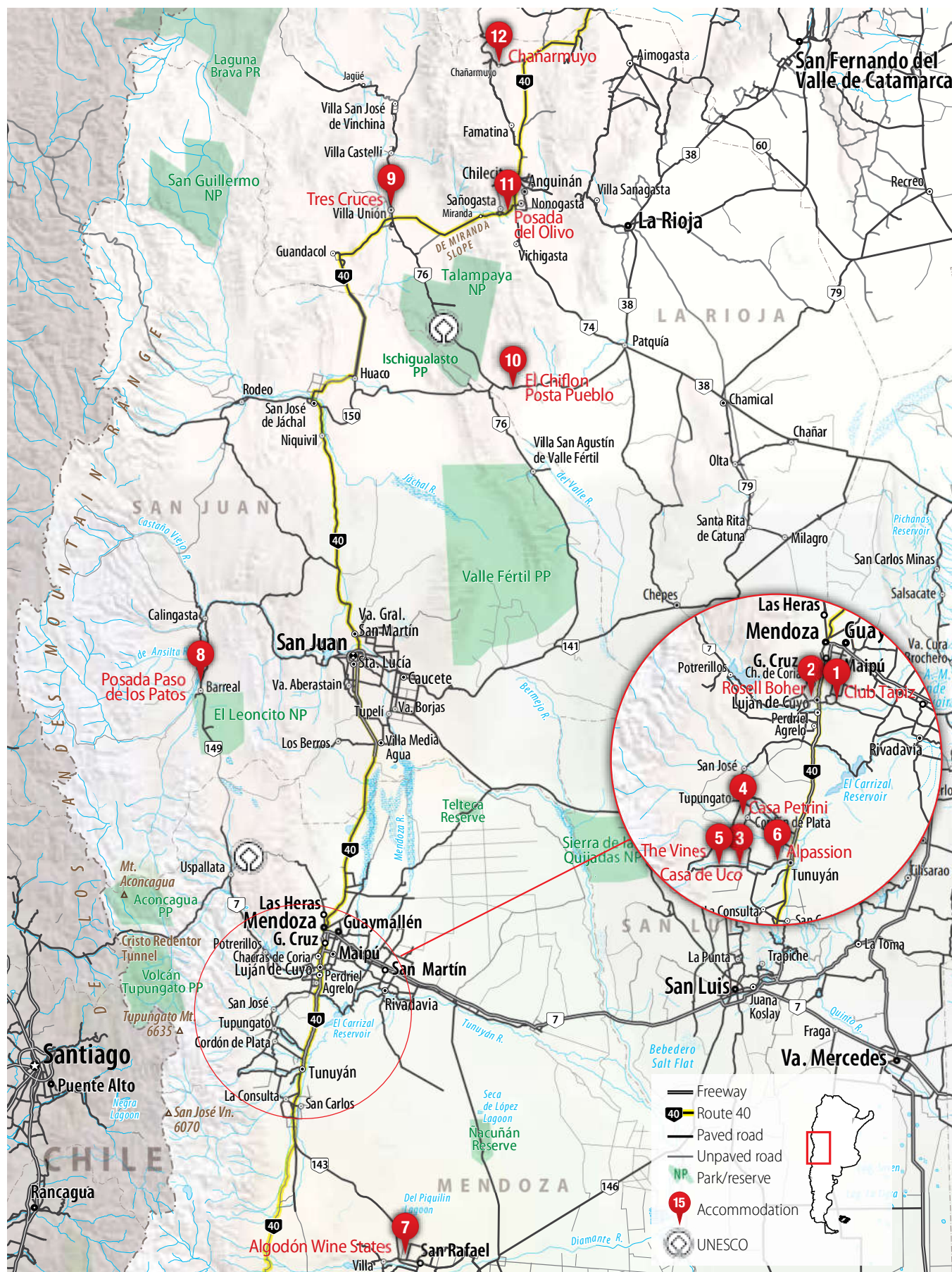
