the evening, we attend a dinner show where you will enjoy the magnetism of tango.

Day 2 Buenos Aires. Ⓑ Day at leisure to explore the city.

Day 3 Buenos Aires / Bariloche.

Ⓑ At due time, transfer to the airport to board the flight to Bariloche. Arrival and accommodation. In the afternoon, we explore Bariloche through the Small Circuit. Our trip borders the Lake Nahuel Huapi until we reach Campanario Hill, where we ascend to obtain great views of the surroundings lakes. 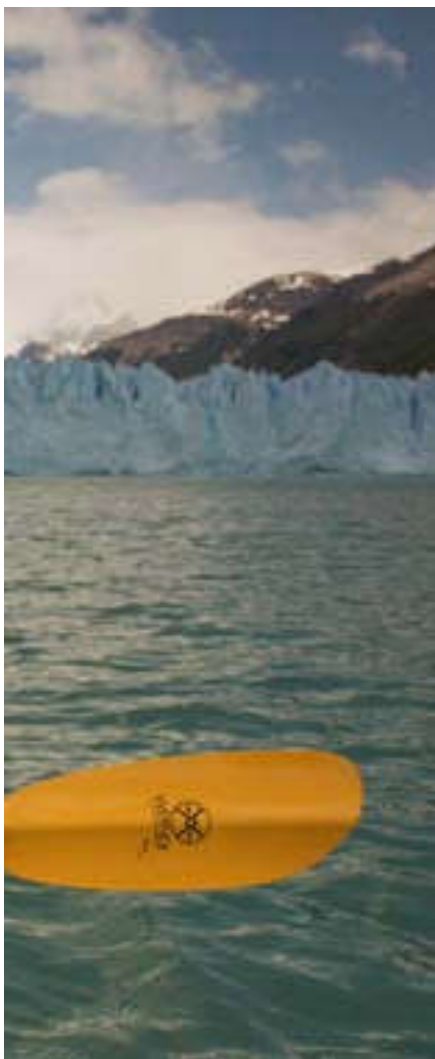

During the tour, a walk along the footbridges located in front of the glacier allows us to admire this impressive natural wonder from different angles. This tour can be enhanced by a one-hour boat ride, that provides a different view of the front of the glacier from the water level, which helps us appreciate its real height. Free time for lunch (not included). In the afternoon, return to the hotel.

Day 5 El Calafate. Ⓛ Day at leisure. Ideal to make a boat trip through the Lake Argentino or to enjoy activities that will allow you to explore unique landscapes.

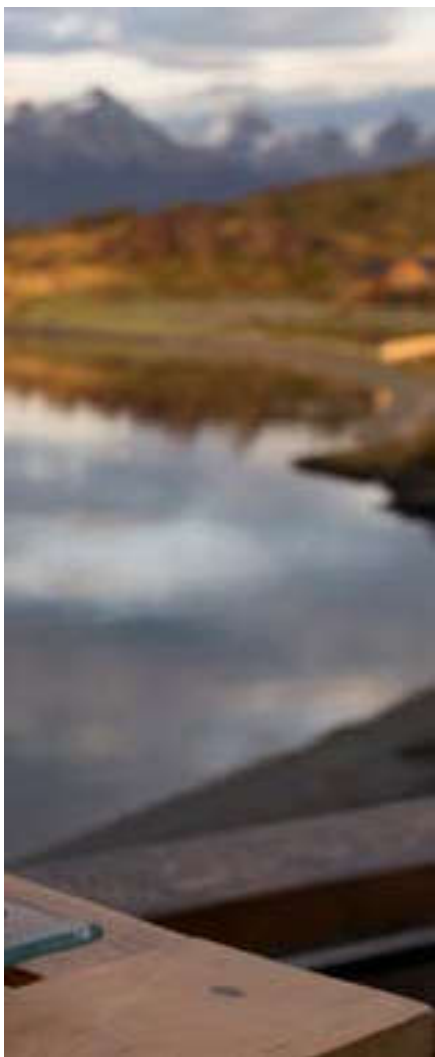

In the afternoon, we land at Wulaia Bay, historic site that used to be one of the biggest settlements of native canoeists called Yamanas. We walk to a viewpoint from where we can appreciate the beauty of the vegetation and geography.

Day 6 Australis Cruise / Pía Glacier / Garibaldi Glacier. ③

① ① We start the day sailing through the northwestern arm of the Beagle Channel to land at the Pía fiord to walk towards its viewpoint.

In the afternoon, we enter the Garibaldi fiord to have a walk to the base of a glacial waterfall. Return to the cruise.

Day 7 Australis Cruise / Agostini Sine / Águila Glacier / Cóndor Glacier. ③ ① ①

Today we push out into the Agostini Sine, where it is possible to appreciate the glaciers that comes down from the centre of the Darwin Mountain Range, some of them reach the sea. During the morning, we land in Zodiac boats to make a soft walk around a lagoon that emerged from the Águila glacier. In the afternoon,

we return to the Zodiac boats to come closer to the C ndor Glacier. We learn about the formation of the glaciers and its influence in the sharp geography of the Patagonian channels.

Day 8 Australis Cruise / Puerto Natales.   Early in the morning we arrive at Magdalena Island, if the climatic conditions allow it, which was a must-stop for the supply of ancient sailors and discoverers. During our walk towards the lighthouse, we can appreciate a wide colony of Magellanic penguins. Finally, we arrive at Punta Arenas. The land is at 11:30 AM. Regular shuttle to Puerto Natales.

Day 9 Torres del Paine.     Full day excursion to Torres del Paine National Park. The Park was declared Biosphere Reserve by the UNESCO in April 1978. The

variety of flora and fauna along the landscapes and geography makes this area one of the most ideal places to practice adventure sports. We admire lakes as the Sarmiento, Nordenskjold and Pehoe, among others. The fauna you may observe are foxes, guanacos and other species. During the tour, there is a huge variety of birds easy to see. We take a short walk towards the Salto Grande, which is a part of the water supply system of the park. The circuit continues to the administration leading to Lake Grey, where it is possible to take a short thirty-minute walk through a native wood in order to reach the lake's coast and admire the icebergs that break off the glacier and now are located at the beach. Box Lunch. Return to the hotel. Accommodation.

Day 10 Puerto Natales / El Calafate.   Regular shuttle to El Calafate. Arrival and reception. Accommodation.

Day 11 El Calafate.   Way out from the hotel to the Perito Moreno Glacier, located at the Los Glaciares National Park. Perito Moreno Glacier is an impressive mass of ice that descends from the Southern Ice Field, causing detachments during its advance, which makes it the only glacier in the world that is constantly moving. This is an awesome spectacle, not only for its beauty but also for the detachments' roars. It was declared World Heritage Site by UNESCO due to its beauty.

Day 12 El Calafate / Buenos Aires.   Time at leisure for optional activities. At due time, transfer to the airport to board

the flight towards Buenos Aires. Arrival and reception at the airport. Transfer to the hotel. Accommodation.

Day 13 Buenos Aires.   Transfer to the airport to board scheduled flight.

Day 8: During September and April, the landing at Magdalena Island is replaced by a landing at Marta Island, where South American sea lions can be spotted from the Zodiac boats.

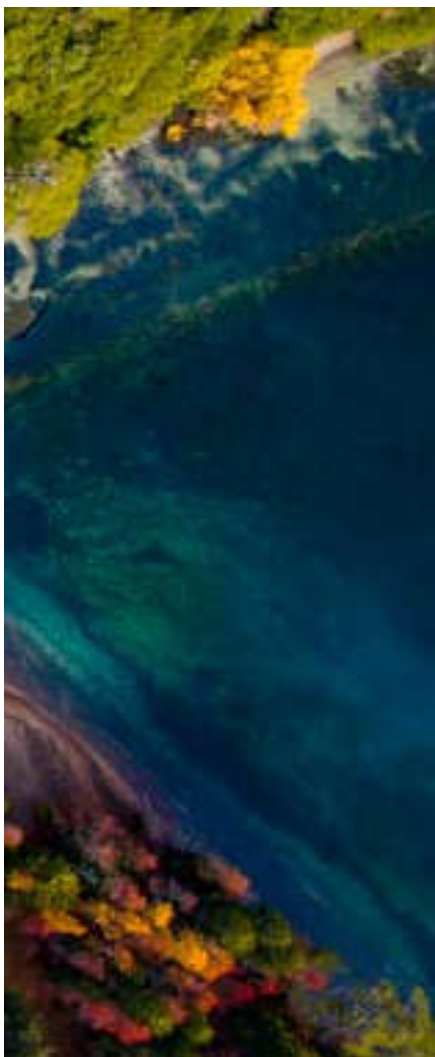

Day 1 Lima. Arrival at Lima and transfer to the hotel.

Day 2 Lima. ☺ Today we explore the historic centre of Lima, declared a Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO. During the tour, we visit some of the most representative buildings of the colonial architecture, such as the Cathedral. At the end, return to the hotel. Afternoon at leisure.

Day 3 Lima / Cusco / Aguas Calientes. ☺ Transfer to the airport to board the flight to Cusco. After arrival, we make a tour through the city including the main square, the Cathedral and the Archeological Park of Sacsayhuaman, one of the most characteristic sites of the Inca heritage. In the afternoon, we head for Ollaytantambo, where we take the train to Aguas Calientes. Arrival.

Day 4 Aguas Calientes / Machu Picchu / Cusco. ☺ ☹ We depart

towards Machu Picchu Ruins, declared a Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO and one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World. In the "Ciudadela", we visit the Intipunku (Sun's Gate), the Inca Bridge, and the Wayna Picchu (subject to availability). After lunch we take the train and bus back to Cusco.

Day 5 Cusco / Puno. ☺ ☹ We leave towards Puno, and on the way, we get to know Raya, considered "The Sistine Chapel of the Americas" and the highest point of the road between Puno and Cusco; the Ruins of Racchi to visit the Temple of Wiracocha (God Sun of the Incas) and the Museum of Pucara. Lunch on the road and arrival at Cusco.

Day 6 Puno / Huatajata. ☺ ☹ Departure towards Copacabana and upon arrival, visit the

Cathedral and the "Indian Virgin", one of the most important pilgrimages centers for Bolivians and Peruvians. Then, aboard a hydrofoil, we visit and get to know the history of the Moon Island. Continue towards Sun Island, where we have lunch before returning to Copacabana. From there, we continue to Huatajata, and visit the Ecoladea and the Altiplano Museum.

Day 7 Huatajata / La Paz. ☺ Today we visit the Archaeological Site of Tiwanaku and get to know the history of one of the oldest civilizations in America. We continue to La Paz but before arriving at the hotel, we enjoy an aerial view of the city from the local cable car. In the afternoon, we visit the city and Valle de la Luna (Moon Valley) where we will

find clay deposits which resemble the moon's surface.

Day 8 La Paz / Buenos Aires. B Transfer to the airport to take the flight to Buenos Aires. Arrival and transfer to the hotel.

Day 9 Buenos Aires. B At due time we join a panoramic tour around the city. We start in Plaza de Mayo (historic square), witness to the most important events of the country since 1810 where we are able to appreciate the surrounding buildings, such as the Casa Rosada (Pink House), the cathedral and the Cabildo (Town Hall). We continue towards San Telmo, one of the oldest neighborhoods where the cultural and architectural heritage of the city has been best preserved. Our next stop is La Boca in order to explore its streets that are surrounded by "conventillos" and

its traditional Caminito alley. We finally visit Recoleta, the aristocratic area of the city.

Day 10 Buenos Aires. B Buenos Aires offers a wide range of activities. We suggest you experience the city through our history, art, gastronomy and passions. Consult for ours tours.

Day 11 Buenos Aires / Iguazu. B Transfer to the airport and flight to Iguazu. Arrival and departure to Iguazu National Park to visit Iguazu Falls, declared a Natural Heritage Site by UNESCO and one of the New Seven Wonders of Nature. During the tour we visit the three circuits of the Park: Garganta del Diablo, the Upper and the Lower Trails. During the tour, we have free time to have lunch (not included) and take optionally the tour "The Great Adventure", a trip through the river

on board a zodiac combined with a walk through the jungle. In the afternoon, return to the hotel.

Day 12 Iguazú / Rio de Janeiro. B

In the morning, we visit the falls on the Brazilian side where we walk along the only catwalk that leads us to Garganta del Diablo's Viewpoint. While we walk, we appreciate a panoramic view of almost all the waterfalls. At due time, transfer to the airport to board the flight to Rio de Janeiro. Arrival and reception.

Day 13 Rio de Janeiro. B Departure from the hotel to visit the highlights of the city and admire the natural beauty of Rio de Janeiro. We arrive to the base of Mt. Corcovado to ascend to the top and enjoy a panoramic view of the city. There we admire the statue of Christ the Redeemer, declared as one of the Seven

Wonders of the Modern World. Then, continue towards the famous Pão de Açúcar which offers a 360° view of Rio de Janeiro, including Botafogo, Copacabana beaches, Mt. Corcovado and the city center.

Day 14 Rio de Janeiro. B Day at leisure to get to know Rio de Janeiro.

Day 15 Rio de Janeiro. B Day at leisure. At due time, transfer to board the scheduled flight.

To keep in mind:

- Puerto Iguazú: The access to Garganta del Diablo may be interrupted by the rise in river flow.
- In case of taking The Great Adventure, please ask its restrictions.
- When staying in Iguazú, there are options of accommodation on the Argentinian side (Puerto Iguazú) or on the Brazilian side (Foz do Iguaçu).
