Day 1 Lima. Arrival and reception at the airport. Transfer to the hotel.

Today we visit Lima, city that was declared Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO. We walk through Del Amor Park in Miraflores, the Government Palace, the Town Hall, the Cathedral and San Francisco Covent, all of them located at the main square. At the end, return to the hotel.

Day 2 Lima / Cusco. (3) Transfer to the airport and flight to Cusco. Arrival and accommodation. In the afternoon, we visit the Archeological Park of Sacsayhuaman, Del Puma Sanctuary, Korikancha Temple, Del Dios Sol Temple, Santo Domingo Church and the main square, where the cathedral is located. Day 3 Cusco. (3) (1) Today we arrive at Aguas Calientes by train, then ascend the winding road to Machu Picchu, one of the Seven Wonders of the World and declared a Cultural and Natural Heritage Site by UNESCO; as it is considered an important religious, political and administrative center of the Inca period. Built in the fifteenth century, Machu Picchu is divided into two large sectors: the agricultural comprising a vast network of artificial terraces, and the urban area, consisting of various buildings and squares, including the Temple of the Sun, the Temple of Three Windows, the

Main Temple and the Temple of the Condor. We have spare time and lunch. In the afternoon, return to Cusco.

Day 4 Cusco/ Foz do Iguaçu. ③
Transfer to the airport to take the flight to Lima, and then connect to Foz do Iguaçu. Arrival, reception and transfer to the hotel.

Day 5 Foz do Iguaçu. 3 In the morning, we visit the falls on the Brazilian side. We enter the National Park and cross the only path that takes us to the viewpoint of Garganta del Diablo. As we walk, we appreciate a view of almost all the falls.

Day 6 Foz do Iguaçu/ Rio de Janeiro. Transfer to the airport of Foz. Arrival and reception in Rio. Transfer to the hotel. Time at leisure. In the evening, we suggest a spectacular samba show with the characteristic rhythm of Carnival.

Day 7 Rio de Janeiro. 3 Departure from the hotel to visit one of the most famous sites in

the city: the statue of Christ the Redeemer, recently chosen as one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World. From its summit, we enjoy a panoramic view of Rio de Janeiro and discover why it is known as the "Marvelous City". After lunch, we visit the famous Pão do Açúcar (Sugar Loaf) located at 395 MASL (1.296 ft.) that has become an icon of the city. From its summit, we are able to glimpse some of the historical sites of the city, such as the cathedral and the municipal theater.

Day 8 Rio de Janeiro. 3 Day at leisure to get to know Rio de Janeiro through its culture and nature.

Day 9 Rio de Janeiro. (3) In due time, transfer to board the scheduled flight.

Day 1 Rio de Janeiro. Arrival and reception at the airport. Transfer to the hotel. Accommodation. Day 2 Rio de Janeiro. (3) Depart to visit Corcovado Hill, where the statue of Christ the Redeemer is located. After lunch, a visit to the Pão de Açúcar. From the top, enjoy a panoramic view of the entire city. Return to the hotel.

Day 3 Rio de Janeiro / Lima. 3 Transfer to the airport to board a flight to Lima. Transfer to the hotel.

Today we visit Lima, declared Cultural Heritage Site. We walk through Del Amor Park in Miraflores, the Government Palace, the Town Hall, the Cathedral and San Francisco Covent, all of them located at the main square. At the end, return to the hotel.

Day 4 Lima / Cusco. (3) Transfer to the airport and flight to Cusco. Arrival and accommodation. In the afternoon, we visit the Archeological Park of Sacsayhuaman, Del Puma Sanctuary, Korikancha Temple, Del Dios Sol Temple, Santo Domingo Church and the main square, where the cathedral is located. Day 5 Cusco. (3) (1) Get to know the Sacred Valley of the Incas, going through the Market of Piscac, where beautiful handicrafts

are made. After lunch, we get

to Ollantaytambo, characterized

by its temple, used as a fortress

during the resistance of Incas. In the evening, return to Cusco. Day 6 Cusco. (B) (I) Today we arrive at Aguas Calientes by train, to later ascend through the winding way to Machu Picchu, Cultural Heritage Site and one of the Seven Wonders of the World. This lost city of the Incas astonishes us with its terraces, ceremonial sanctuaries, stairs and urban zones. Time to walk round the ruins and have lunch. In the evening, return to Cusco.

Day 7 Cusco / Puerto Iguazú. (3) Transfer to board the connecting flight to Foz do Iguaçu. Arrival and transfer to the selected hotel.

Day 8 Puerto Iguazú. (3) Departure from the hotel towards Iguazú National Park, Natural Heritage Site and one of the Seven Wonders of the World. During the walk along the paths, it is possible to get a panoramic view of San Martin Island and Bossetti, San Martin and Tres Mosqueteros Waterfalls. Return to the hotel. Day 9 Puerto Iguazú / Buenos Aires. (3) In the morning, we visit

the falls on the Brazilian side. We enter the National Park and cross the only path that takes us to the viewpoint of Garganta Del Diablo. As we walk, we appreciate a view of almost all the falls. Transfer to Puerto Iguazú to board the flight to Buenos Aires. Arrive and transfer to the hotel.

Day 10 Buenos Aires. 3 0 Today we discover the city through its most interesting places: the historical Centre, La Boca neighborhood, with its famous Caminito Street, Palermo and La Recoleta neighborhoods. In the evening, feel delighted by a dinner and tango show.

Day 11 Buenos Aires. (3) Day at leisure to take optional tours. We suggest "Gaucho Party" or "Tigre Delta".

Day 1 Santiago. Reception at the airport in Santiago and transfer to the hotel.

In the afternoon, departure to Discover the city by visiting the main streets of the civic neighbourhood, Parque Forestal, and the Bellavista neighbourhood; an area that brings together the best of Santiago's bohemian scene. At the end, return to the hotel.

Day 5 Mendoza. (3) (1) We leave the hotel to discover the Catena World. This High Range Tour offers us an insight on the family that brought Argentine wines to the world and is designed to get to

know, taste and enjoy the best wines of our terroir. The wineries to be visited are Catena Zapata, Bodega Caro and Casa El Enemigo, inspired by the childhood of Alejandro Vigil, head winemaker of Catena Zapata.

Day 6 Mendoza / Buenos Aires. B Free morning to continue discovering the city. At the indicated time, transfer to the airport to board the plane for Buenos Aires. In the evening, we attend a wine tasting where we discover the world of Malbec and other varieties that have brought Argentine wine to a privileged place.

Day 7 Buenos Aires. 3 1 In the morning, we will explore the city, visiting its most emblematic sites. In the evening, we enjoy a gastronomic experience that explores new ways of serving the typical Argentinean Asado (barbecue).

Day 8 Buenos Aires. 3 Free day to experience the city through our history, art, gastronomy and passions.

Day 9 Buenos Aires/

Montevideo. (3) Departure to the port to board the ferry that will take you to Montevideo. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel to then go on a city tour.

Ecuador: Tradition and Nature

Day 1 Quito. Arrival and reception at the airport. Accommodation.

Day 2 Quito. (3) (1) After breakfast, we start a walk through La Calle Ronda, letting us imagine how local inhabitants used to live in the 1600s. Afterwards, we visit the colonial city of Quito including Santo Domingo Square, the City Museum, San Francisco Square, La Merced Church, the Presidential Palace, the Cathedral

and other important buildings. Our last stop is La Compañía de Jesús Church, one of the most beautiful ones around the world. After visiting Itchimbia, we get at the historical site where Zero Latitude was found in 1736. Lunch at a restaurant. We visit the Ethnographical Museum and the Inti Ñan Museum. Return to the

Day 3 Quito. (3) Day at leisure. We suggest visiting the Handcraft Market of Otavalo, famous for its textiles, tapestries and traditional shops.

Day 4 Quito / Puerto Ayora.

(B) In the morning, transfer to the airport to board the flight to Santa Cruz, one of the Galápagos archipelago's islands, famous for its numerous endemic species and the studies of Charles Darwin that led him to establish his Theory of Evolution by natural selection. **UNESCO** declared the Galapagos Islands as a Natural Heritage Site and as a Biosphere Reserve. It is also a National Park and the sea

that surrounds the islands was declared a Marine Reserve. In 2001, UNESCO added other recognitions such as Whale Sanctuary and RASMAR Site (for the protection of wetlands). Once we arrive and cross the Itabaca Channel, we begin the trip to Puerto Ayora. On the way, we visit the lava tunnels, a giant turtle reserve and at Puerto Ayora, the Charles Darwin Scientific station. It is possible, though perhaps unlikely, that among the remaining giant tortoises of the Galápagos Islands, there exists an old-timer that was a hatchling at the time of Charles Darwin's famous visit in 1835. Giant tortoises are the longest-lived of all vertebrates, averaging over 100 years. Modern Galápagos tortoises can weigh up to 417 kg (919 lb). Accommodation.

Day 5 Puerto Ayora. (3) In the morning, departure to Tortuga Bay. After a walk, we get at one of the most beautiful beaches of the Galapagos, where we have the chance to rest and

enjoy the place before returning to Puerto Ayora, spare time for lunch. In the afternoon, we go through La Lobería, a posting of sea lions, where we are able to do snorkel. Continue towards Del Amor Channel and De Los Perros

Day 6 & 7 Puerto Ayora. 3 1 Excursion by yacht to one of the following Islands: Plazas, Seymour, Bartolomé, Santa Fe or similar. Lunch included. Return to Puerto Avora.

Day 8 Puerto Ayora / Quito or Guayaquil. (3) Transfer to the airport, to board the flight back to Quito or Guayaquil, according to your next destination.

Operational note:

The operation of the tours in Galapagos is subject to availability, changes in the itinerary, operational days, etc.
