Day 1 Arrival, reception at Ezeiza International Airport and transfer to the hotel. In the afternoon, we make a panoramic tour of the city. We start in Plaza de Mayo, witness to the most important

events of the country since 1810. There, we are able to appreciate the surrounding buildings like the 'Pink House' (Government house), the Cathedral and Town Hall. We continue towards La Boca to walk along the famous Caminito alley and its colourful "conventillos". We leave the southern area of the city to head north towards Palermo and Recoleta, where we make a final stop to appreciate the contrast of what we have seen with this aristocratic district,

famous for its cemetery where relevant personalities are buried. Return to the hotel.

Day 2 & 3 🇧 Days at leisure. Buenos Aires offers many options. During these days we suggest you experience the city through its history, art and gastronomy, in order to understand the passion that generates. Please, consult the great variety of tours we offer.

Day 4 🇧 At due time, transfer to the local or international airport, to board the scheduled flight.

To keep in mind:

In private service we suggest adding a guided visit to Colon Theatre, one of the five best Opera's theatres in the world, a stop at a remarkable bar or at El Ateneo Grand Splendid, considered one of the most beautiful libraries in the world. In the evenings, do not miss the opportunity to enjoy a gastronomic tour or enjoy a Dinner Tango Show, a must-see.

Viewpoints of Buenos Aires

Get to know the city from its heights and enjoy its architectural heritage. We begin at El Cabildo (Town Hall) and from its balcony, view of Plaza de Mayo we get a unique panoramic view, Plaza de Mayo. Continue towards Galeria Guemes, a viewpoint that offers a 360-degree view of the city and end at Barolo Palace where Dante's

Divine Comedy is present in the atmosphere.

To keep in mind:
 • Cabildo close on Monday, Güemes Gallery on Saturday. During those day each viewpoint will be replaced by the one in the English Tower.

Divine Buenos Aires

Get to know the city and its lights from the ground as well from the sky. Visit Barolo Palace to learn about the history of this building where the allegory of Dante Alighieri's Divine Comedy is present. Arrive at its dome from where you can see how the lighthouse illuminates the city. After enjoying the view, we visit an office, which is set like 1920,

and taste a glass of wine while we hear a violin, a tango or cello depending on the day.

Duration: 3 hours
Meals: Glass of wine

The Authentic Tour

If you seek to know the city and at the same time discover how "being a Porteño", this tour is for you. During the tour, we visit some of the sites that have an importance for those who live in the city: The Obelisk, Plaza de Mayo, La Boca and La Recoleta. In order to reach the different attractions, we move by subway,

bus and taxi. While travelling by taxi, we learn more about the origin of the bus and its eternal rivalry with the yellow-roofed cars. As we travel, learn about Porteños' customs, idioms and idiosyncrasies.

Walking Tour Southern Area

Discover the historic center of the city starting at the site where the first foundation of the city took place: the Lezama Park. Through a walk along Defensa street we join this point with Plaza de Mayo as we pass by buildings and churches of great historical value. Option to enter Zanjón de Granados, historic tunnel.

Operates: Daily
except Sundays. AM / PM

Meals: 1 drink at Remarkable Bar
Distance: 3 kms (1,8 mile)

To keep in mind:

- We suggest not taking the tour on Sundays, due to San Telmo's Fair
- It is possible to add the visit to Zanjón de Granados except Saturdays.

Walking tour Northern Area

The tour begins in Plaza San Martin where we get to know part of its history as well as the surrounding palaces. We continue towards 9 de Julio Avenue and then walk along Alvear Avenue, where we find a series of aristocratic residences, which provides to the avenue a Parisian atmosphere. During the tour we pass by the sophisticated Alvear

Palace, the Recoleta Cemetery and La Isla, a small sector characterized by its passages with stairways.

La Boca

This tour is for those who want to learn about the history of a neighbourhood, which is important in the construction of the Porteño. Football, tango and pizza are breathed in every corner of this part of the city. During the tour we get to understand how the arrival of immigrants changed inhabitants' life and how their idioms and customs gave rise to lunfardo (Porteños' slang) and

tango. Also how pizza and football are main characters of its streets. At the end, we visit La Bombonera Museum and we learn about the story of Boca Juniors and its rivalry with River Plate.

Meals: Pizza tasting

a 'vermateria' and learn about this gastronomic ritual, which grew through years, and enjoy dinner. Not recommended for those on a diet.

A closed-door gastronomic experience that explores new ways of serving typical Asado's meat cuts. The Chef has designed the tasting menu in order to combine the new grill techniques with true and tasted Argentinian

recipes, which take the Asado to a higher level. The wines have been chosen to enhance the ingredients flavours, proposing some of the best boutiques wines from Argentina.



Bares & Cafés Notables (Remarkable Bars)

Some bars in the city used to be a meeting place for musicians, writers, actors and politicians. Many of them, by antiquity, architecture or local relevance, were considered “remarkable” and are part of the cultural heritage of the city. Feel welcome and share a coffee chat, enjoying a classic

“cortado” (typical coffee with a dash of milk), which is a must and an unforgettable experience for travellers. The tour includes bars from San Telmo, Congreso, Barrio Norte and Recoleta.

Mataderos Fair

Just half an hour from downtown, the city's physiognomy changes with the Mataderos Fair. In front of the old Hacienda Market (where cattle arrived to be controlled and sold), there are more than 700 stalls where it is possible to find from fine pieces of silverware to mates, ponchos, blankets and leather objects. An authentic folkloric fair in the middle of the city.

Duration: 5/6 hours
Season: March to December
Operates: Sundays during daytime
Meals: lunch

To keep in mind:
 The fair does not operate in January. In February, it can just operate during the night subject to confirmation



Zanjón de Granados, Buenos Aires

Tunnels of Buenos Aires

Get to know the colonial Buenos Aires through its old buildings such as the Zanjón de Granados which tells us 4 centuries of history; the Church of San Ignacio de Loyola, the oldest in the city, and the Museum of the Casa Rosada, located at the same place where the Fort of Buenos Aires and Taylor Customs used to be.
Operates: WED /THU /FRI /SUN

Evita, Buenos Aires

Evita: Beyond the Myth

A tour of the relevant sites that help us to understand why Eva was one of the most important female personalities in the Argentinian history. During the tour, we pass by Retiro area, the Luna Park Stadium, the CGT (General Confederation of Labour) that was her foundation's headquarters, Plaza de Mayo and La Recoleta, where we visit her

grave. Meanwhile, we stop at Tabac Café, a Remarkable bar with a story to learn.

developed; Boedo and Almagro, cradle of personalities and tango bars. We finish in Las Violetas bar which was chosen as the best city's Remarkable Bar, where we will enjoy a light lunch.

Carlos Gardel's History

If we speak about Tango, anything better than knowing a bit about Carlos Gardel's history, the most important tango singer of all times. The tour includes two relevant neighbourhoods: San Nicolás, passing by some sites where he was raised, Tortoni Café and Los Angelitos Café, and Abasto neighbourhood which gave him the nickname "Morochito

del Abasto". We visit the house where he lived that nowadays is a museum, the Zelaya Passage where there are murals of him, the Gardel Walk with his monument and the Chanta Cuatro Corner where there was a tanguería.

Milongas Tour, Buenos Aires

Milongas Tour

This option allows us to discover tango in a different way. The "Porteños" who dance tango, prefer to go to the milongas, and here is where we are going to take you. Do you want to know what the "cabecero" (nod) is? Why is music heard in "Tandas" and why are the tables distributed around the track? Why do dancers circulate against the hands of the

clock? For three to four hours, you are able to learn about tango, take a lesson and enjoy tango with locals.
Operates: Private daily. Regular MON / WED / SUN

Tango Lesson

Tango is a characteristic dance of the Rio de la Plata region, which was spread throughout the world. It is characterized by the close embrace of the couple, the tango walk, the "corte" and "quebrada", and the improvisation. Enjoy an hour with a tango instructor to learn the basics of this dance that makes people from all over the world fall in love with

it. Taking one or several tango lessons during your stay and then attending a typical milonga is a good way to experience this dance in the most authentic way.

Southern Bike Tour

We start our tour at one of the oldest and with great diversity of cultures in Buenos Aires City: San Telmo neighbourhood. We continue towards La Boca to explore the neighbourhood and then go on to Puerto Madero, the city's most modern and sophisticated neighbourhood. While in this area, we arrive to the Costanera Sur Ecological Reserve,

where we share one of the most symbolic rituals of Argentinian culture: the "mate". The tour finishes in Plaza de Mayo (Mayo's Square).

Distance: 17 km (10 miles)
Difficulty: Low

Northern Bike Tour

A tour that includes: Lezama Park, La Boca neighbourhood discovering the tango's origins, its art and the typical colourful "conventillos". Continue towards Puerto Madero, the city's most modern and sophisticated neighbourhood. There we make our main stop to have lunch in a classic parrilla. Then continue to the Costanera Sur Ecological

Reserve, Plaza de Mayo (May's Square), the aristocrat Buenos Aires with its parks and palaces, and finally Recoleta's Cemetery, the oldest and most famous in the city.

Distance: 26 km (16 miles)
Difficulty: Medium



Tigre, Buenos Aires

Tigre with Kayak

An adventure day: train, bike and kayak in the Delta del Paraná. After an introduction and safety talk, we take the train to the point where we begin our trip by bike to Tigre and the Delta. After exploring Tigre, the Puerto de Frutos (Port of Fruits) and Victoria Walk, we change the bikes and helmets for lifejackets and kayak in order to start the activity. We

arrive to an island where the typical asado is waiting for us. After that, return in the same way.

Operates: MON-WED-FRI
Duration: 9 hours
Meals: Lunch
Distance: 30 km (18 miles) by bike and 5 km (3 miles) by kayak
Difficulty: Medium-high



Polo Day, Buenos Aires

Polo day

It is an excursion planned to make you a polo player for a day. The day starts with a talk about the game and polo's horses, while we taste "empanadas" and a good Argentinian wine.

After learning about the rules, equipment and the different tailshot's techniques, we attend a live professional polo match.

After lunch, we have a polo lesson where you will learn to ride a horse and to handle the stick. It concludes with a mini polo match. We finish this day with a horseback riding.

Day 1 Arrival and reception at the airport. Transfer to the hotel.

Day 2 ☺ In the morning, we depart towards the Iguazú

National Park to visit the Iguazú Falls, declared a Natural Heritage Site by UNESCO and one of the Seven Wonders of the Natural World. During the tour, we go through the three circuits of the Park: Garganta del Diablo (to reach the balcony and viewpoint of the most imposing falls of the Park), The Upper Trail (that provides a view of the falls from above) and The Lower Trail (that offers a closer contact with the vegetation and the falls). During

the tour, free time to have lunch (not included) and to take The Great Adventure (optional). This boat ride takes you into the very heart of the falls followed by a walk through the jungle. In the afternoon, return to the hotel.

Day 3 ☺ In the morning, we visit the Brazilian side of the Falls. Once inside the National Park, we walk along the only path that leads us to Garganta del Diablo viewpoint. As we walk, we appreciate a view of almost all the waterfalls.

At due time, transfer to the airport.

To keep in mind:

- Accommodation in Iguazú can be on the Argentinian side (Puerto Iguazú) or on the Brazilian side (Foz de Iguazú).
- The access to Garganta del Diablo can be interrupted because of the rise in river flow.
- In case of taking The Great Adventure, check with us its restrictions.

A trekking through one of the less visited paths of the Park, to access a 360° viewpoint from where we can appreciate Fitz Roy, Torre and Toro Valleys, the Patagonian Steppe and the huge Viedma Lake. In the last part of the tour, we are able to appreciate a large number of ancient marine fossils. Feel the wind of Patagonia as we look out over a natural viewpoint located at an approximate height

of 1500 MASL (4.921 ft.) to get a view of the Torre and Fitz Roy summits.

Once at Punta Sur, we embark and after 30 minutes of boat trip, we contemplate the huemul and Vespignani glaciers, we arrive at the Vespignani Glacier Reserve Area to descend and choose the path to trek: difficult, intermediate or easy. From the

two most demanding circuits, it is possible to appreciate closely the Vespignani Glacier and the northern face of Mount Fitz Roy. We stay for 2 hours and return to El Chalten.

Day 2 Today we visit Los Alerces National Park, recently declared Natural Heritage Site by the UNESCO and created for the protection of larches, one of the oldest trees in the continent, which used to be in danger of extinction.

The tour includes the visit to Villa Futalaufquen and its lake, Limonao port, Irigoyen waterfall and the walkways of Arrayanes River where we take a short walk to see a young larch of 300 years old, appreciate Verde Lake and finally get to Chucao Port by the shore of Lake Menendez. From this point, the boat trips to a millennial larch departs. In the afternoon, we return to Esquel.

Day 3 Free day to take an optional excursion. If you like

adventure, we recommend taking the tour to Piedra Parada, an amazing place to discover.

Day 4 Free morning and at due time, transfer to the Esquel airport to board your scheduled flight.

To keep in mind:

La Trochita operates on Saturdays mornings but depending on the demand, an additional departure in the afternoon is offered. Ask for schedule.

La Trochita

The Old Patagonian Express, known as “La Trochita”, is one of the best-preserved historical trains in the world and due to its importance, this relic of 75 cm (29 inches) of gauge was declared a National Historic Landmark. The route is carried out for 18 km (22 miles) of the original one until reaching the Nahuel Pan station where a Mapuche community lives. There is a museum and

stands where they sell typical crafts of the area. While the train makes maneuvers to return to Esquel, passengers visit the community.

Piedra Parada (The Standing Stone)

After travelling 140 km (86 miles), we enter the steppe towards the Valley of Chubut River where Piedra Parada is located. We cross the river to the entrance of De La Buitrera Canyon,

a fault in the rock, and walk through its interior discovering strange shapes. After lunch, we go on a hike of medium-high difficulty to contemplate a small petrified forest.

There, we have the chance to see the basins where snow began to







Valparaíso, Santiago de Chile

Valparaíso and Viña del Mar

Departure from the hotel towards the Pacific Ocean through Casablanca Valley known due to its vines. When approaching to the coast, visit the beaches and Viña del Mar City in order to continue to the picturesque Valparaíso's Port. Due to its particular architecture, UNESCO declared its historic centre Humanity's Heritage. The city is

located next to some hills that can be reached by alleys, long stairs and diverse lifts which were built between the end of XIX century and early XX century.

Isla Negra, Santiago de Chile

Negra Island

Departure from the hotel to visit the beach area in Negra Island, which is characterized by its dense vegetation and big pine trees. There, the house-museum of Pablo Neruda, who was a Chilean poet and Nobel Peace Prize winner, is located. In the house's interior, find his collections of bottles, figureheads,

conchas and other objects that the poet collected along his life. This house was built in 1939 and its architecture is very particular due to the low cost materials combination and the artistic wealth. After the excursion, return to the hotel.

Concha and Toro

Departure from the hotel to Maipo Valley, Pirque's area, famous because of its high quality in wines productions, to visit the vineyard Concha and Toro. Founded in 1883, it is the biggest wines exporter in Chile. The tour includes a walk through the gardens, the park, the house's exterior side and

the storage cellars such as the centenary Casillero del Diablo, which has a legend that surprises its inhabitants. The tour includes reserve wines tastings and a visit to the wine shop where you will find all its products.

Colchagua's Route

Departure from the hotel to Colchagua's Valley, two and a half hours to the south of Santiago, where is possible to visit two of the following vineyards: Casa Silva Vine, Estampa, Jacques & Francois Lurton, Laura Hartwig, Montes, Mont Gras, Viu Manent or Viña Bisquertt, according to the day. After doing the visits

Day 1 Arrival at San Pedro de Atacama. Transfer to the hotel. In the afternoon, departure from the hotel to visit De La Sal Mountain Range and De La

Muerte Valley. During the trip, we arrive at Las Tres Marias, an interesting geological formation, located close to an old salt mine and to De La Luna Valley (Moon Valley), named after its similarity with the lunar landscape. Enjoy a unique sunset.

Day 2 ☺ Free day to take an optional excursion. We suggest visiting Altiplanic Lagoons, one of the 7 areas which embrace Los Flamencos National Reserve ("flamencos" means flamingoes), with Chaxa Lagoon in Atacama

Salt Flat. Volcanoes and mountainous relief, standing out Miscanti and Miñiques Lagoons, characterize the landscape. On the way back, we visit Toconao. **Max. altitude: 4.220 MASL (13,845 ft.)**

Day 3 ☺ Early in the morning we depart towards El Tatio Geysir Field, a geothermal field located in the Andes Mountain Range, which is the highest geysir field in the world (4.200 MASL- 13.779 ft.). It is visited during the first hours of the day because at that time, it registers an impressive activity of

vapor fumaroles produced by the high temperatures of its watery craters. It is surrounded by hills that reach 5.900 MASL (10.356 ft.). **Max. altitude: 4.320 MASL (14.173 ft.)**

Day 4 ☺ At due time, departure transfer.

To keep in mind: Due to the area's characteristics such as altitude, atmospheric pressure and reduction of oxygen, we recommend people with respiratory, cardiac or pressure diseases, should take special care.

Archeological tour, San Pedro de Atacama, Chile

Archaeological Tour

We leave the hotel to visit Tulo's Village which is around 3.000 years old and its architecture was made with circular clay constructions. After that, we visit the Atacama's fortress known as Pukará de Quito, which was built in the XII century. The Pukará de Quito's ruins show us the

great social organization that the Atacama's ancestors had against the Spanish conquerors. These ruins are located at the slope of a small hill, which gave them a strategic location.


Astronomical Tour

Live this experience under one of the best skies in the world. identify planets, binary stars and others. Return to the hotel.

Cejar lagoon, San Pedro de Atacama, Chile

Cejar Lagoon

On this tour we visit a series of lagoons in the interior of the Atacama Salt Flat, the largest salt flat in Chile. Then continue to Cejar and Piedra lagoon, surrounded by green and yellow grass which highlights the colour of the water, contemplating a unique landscape of turquoise water and volcanoes. In Piedra

Lagoon, we enjoy a different bath, due to its saline water that allow the bodies to float and remain without sinking, because the salt load is greater than the weight of the person. After sunset, we return to S.P. de Atacama.

Duration: 4 hours

Altitude: 2400 MASL (7874 ft.)



Pukara of Quito, S.P. Atacama, Chile

Quitor & Catarpe Bike Tour

We start an active bike ride with more than 6 river crossing. Feel the adrenaline of going by the Cordillera de la Sal. Catarpe is the only green valley in this area and stands out for its small church and the walk, which we will take to the summit of Pucara de Quito, ruins of an old fortress from the XI century. This pre Inca construction was declared

a National monument in 1982 for being a key testimony, which shows the development and evolution of these communities in the Antofagasta region.

Operates: daily

Duration: 4 hours

Altitude: 2530 MASL (8300 ft.)



Altiplanic lagoons, San Pedro de Atacama

Altiplanic Lagoons, Atacama Salt Flat and Toconao

We travel 350 kilometers (217 miles) approximately, visiting the towns of Toconao and Socaire, the Valley of Jeri and the Chaxa Lagoon in the Salar de Atacama, habitat of pink flamingos. The excursion continues to the high plateau lagoons, 18 kilometers (11 miles) south of Socaire, in one of the 7 areas which embrace

Los Flamencos National Reserve. These lagoons are surrounded by imposing volcanoes caused by the rise of the Andes, in remote geological times.

Operates: daily

Duration: 8 hours

Altitude: 4.500 MASL (14.763 ft.)



Salar de Tara, San Pedro de Atacama

Monks of Pecana and Tara Salt Flat

The tour leaves from San Pedro through Jama International Pass at an approximate height of 4.000 meters. On the way, we observe the Quepiaco river wetland, which contrasts with the colours of the mountain range. Later we reach the area where the Pacana Monks are located, which are a group of imposing stone pillars

formed by the erosion of wind and water located in the middle of the desert. We continue towards Tara Salt Flat ascending to 4.000 meters where we walk along its lagoon. Time for lunch and return to San Pedro.

Continue to Rano Raraku Volcano, area with the highest concentration of statues in the island and place where the moais used to be carved. Finally, Ahu Tongariki, the biggest ceremonial site in the island, where many of the huge moai were

destroyed by a large tsunami in 1960. The tour ends at Anakena which contains two ceremonial sites.

Day 3 **B** The tour starts visiting Vinapu in order to continue to Rano Kau, volcano of 310 MASL (1.017 ft), which contains a huge crater of 1.6 km (1 mile) diameter and a 11 mt. deep (36 ft.) fresh water lagoon. Next to the volcano is the ancient ceremonial city of Orongo, area of the island where we can find the greatest concentration of petroglyphs. In the afternoon, excursion to Ahu Akivi, a

ceremonial site which is particularly interesting not only because of its location in the centre of the island but also because of the legends about its Seven Moais. Then, we visit Puna Pau, located on the east side of Hanga Roas town, in a small red stone crater.

Day 4 **B** At due time transfer to the airport.


